



“For God so love the world, that He gave His only begotten Son; that whosoever believes on Him should not perish, but have everlasting life. For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through Him might be saved” (John 3:16-17). Jesus said unto her, I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live: (John 11:25 KJV).



First Step: is to recognize there is a penalty for sin. The Bible said, “For the wages of sin is death” (Romans 6:23-a). Let me give you an illustration. Suppose you were to work for me for a day and I gave you fifty dollars; the fifty dollars represent your wages; When we sin you and I earned Spiritual death.

Second Step: know for certain that unless your sins are forgiven, you cannot go to heaven. God is Holy, He will not allow sin where He lives The Bible says, “Whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire” (Revelation 20:15).



Third step: God has provided for us eternal life in heaven, through His Son Jesus Christ. The Bible says, “God is not willing that any should perish, but have everlasting life” (See John 3:16-b). On Calvary’s Cross our sin debt was paid in full, if we receive Jesus as our Savior, we will receive eternal life.

Receive Jesus as your Savior



The fourth step is to repent, ask God for forgiveness of our sins; and ask Jesus to be our Savior and Lord. The Bible teaches as many received Him, to them He gave power to become sons (or Children) of God (*John 1:12*). God is not willing that any should perish, (*Perish means go to Hell*) but that all should come to repentance (*2 Peter 3:9-b*).

Will you pray now! Confess your sins before God and repent of them. Repent mean to be sorry enough for your sins to stop sinning. Ask God forgiveness for your sins, then ask Jesus Christ to come into your heart and be your Savior and Lord. Even though you did not choose to be born a sinner, it is solely your choice to remain one!
